Applying

- Form and lodgement
- Visa application charge
- Evidence of enrolment
- Pre-requisite visa – applying onshore
- Evidence of welfare arrangements

GTE

- General Temporary Entrant requirement
 - Circumstances in home country
 - Circumstances in Australia
 - Immigration history
 - Value of the course to the future
 - Any other matter

English and Financials

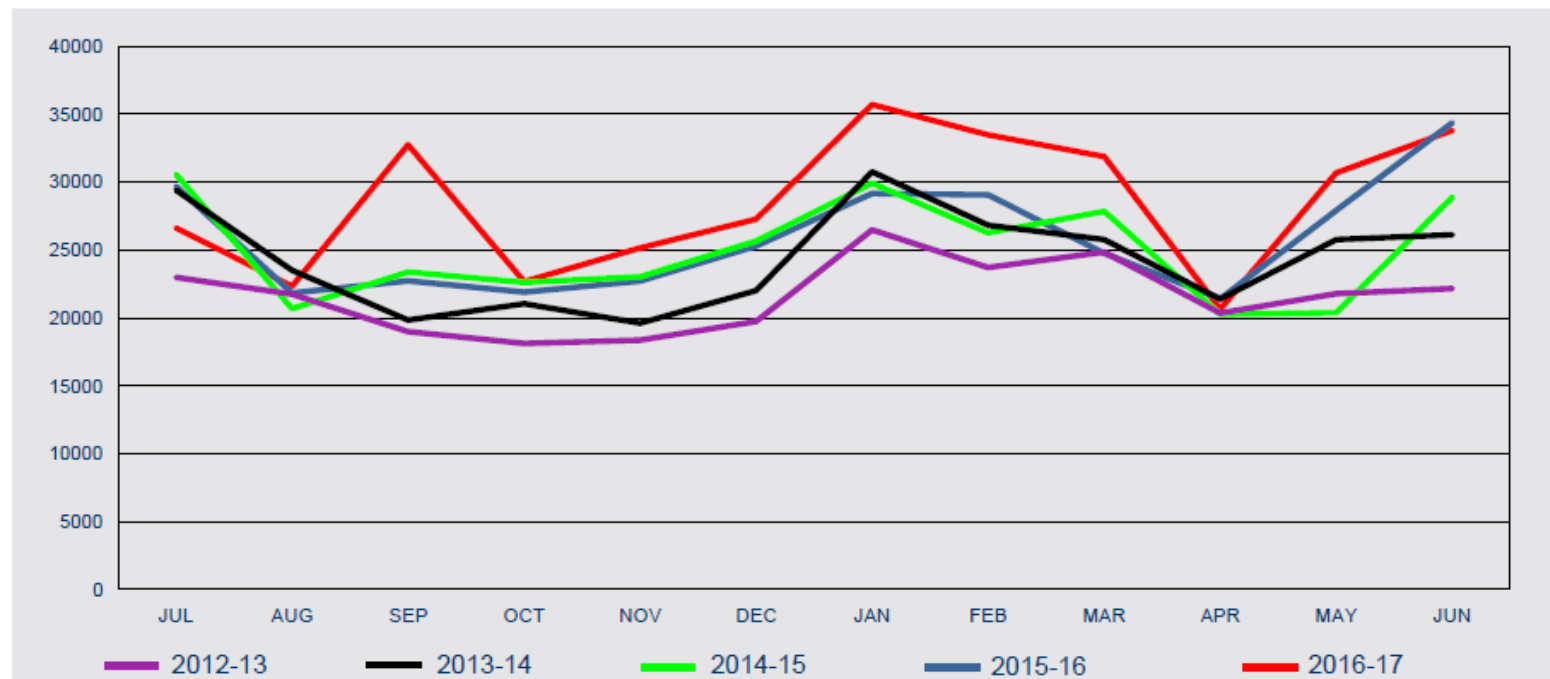
- Every applicant must meet.
- Acceptable test result or falling into an exempt category.
- 12 months or funds or annual income provisions.
- Genuine access.

Student visa conditions

- Working in Australia
- Condition 8202
- Health insurance
- Tell provider of change in details
- Health insurance maintained
- Welfare maintained

What has happened in 2016-17?

2.02 Number of student visa applications granted in 2016-17 to 30 June 2017 by month - comparison with previous four financial years



Visa reform

- Abolition of 457 visa
 - 457 changes do not directly impact student visa holders or graduates looking to apply for a Temporary Graduate visa
- Government's visa reform agenda
